Programmes will not only cast light on those worldviews, beliefs, and practices that have contributed to the crisis of earth's sustainability, but will also explore and promote ways of thinking, acting, and believing that will support the healing of earth and the transformation of the human species.

Design, implement, and evaluate the long- and short-term sabbatical programmes.

Oversee sabbatical programme. Recruit and manage the admissions process for sabbatical participants. Accompany the sabbatical group on educational outings.

Collaborate in planning, preparing and facilitation of courses and workshops that raise awareness and understanding of earth literacy, biodiversity and sustainability.

Collaborate in planning, preparing and facilitation of seasonal celebrations e.g. winter/summer solstices, spring/autumn equinoxes.

Initiate, plan and facilitate group days of reflection and tours.

Develop relationships and collaborate with other like-minded Ecology Centres.
